Welcome aboard Greg!

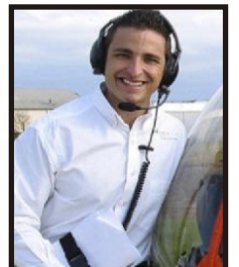


Vic Lorusso
